

Pet Emergency Checklist: be ready when it matters most

Emergency Kit

- Clean towels or cloths (for bleeding or comfort)
- Pet-safe antiseptic wipes or solution
- Gauze pads and bandages
- Digital thermometer
- Tweezers (for splinters or stingers)
- Muzzle or soft restraint (only if safe to use)
- Pet carrier or crate
- Lead and harness
- Gloves (for handling injuries safely)

Home Preparation

- Know the location of your emergency kit
- Keep a list of your pet's medications and medical history
- Have a plan for overnight care if needed
- Identify a quiet, safe space for recovery at home

In Case of Emergency

- Stay calm and assess the situation
- Contact your Triovet immediately on  01354 694794
- Transport your pet safely or find a safe place to wait for our ambulance to arrive
- Provide basic first aid if advised and safe to do so
- Avoid giving food, water, or medication unless instructed
